



Policy Labs use a range of methods, including but not limited to:


- Design (Service Design, Policy Design, User-centred Design, Design Thinking, etc)
- Behavioural insights/economics
- Randomised control trials
- Data science (Big data, Dynamic systems modelling)
- Digital R&D
- Co-production (Co-creation, Co-design)
- Ethnography
- Nudge/Lean

The three dominant approaches are:



What is the difference between a traditional policy process and a design-led policy policy process?








What is the policy design process?


